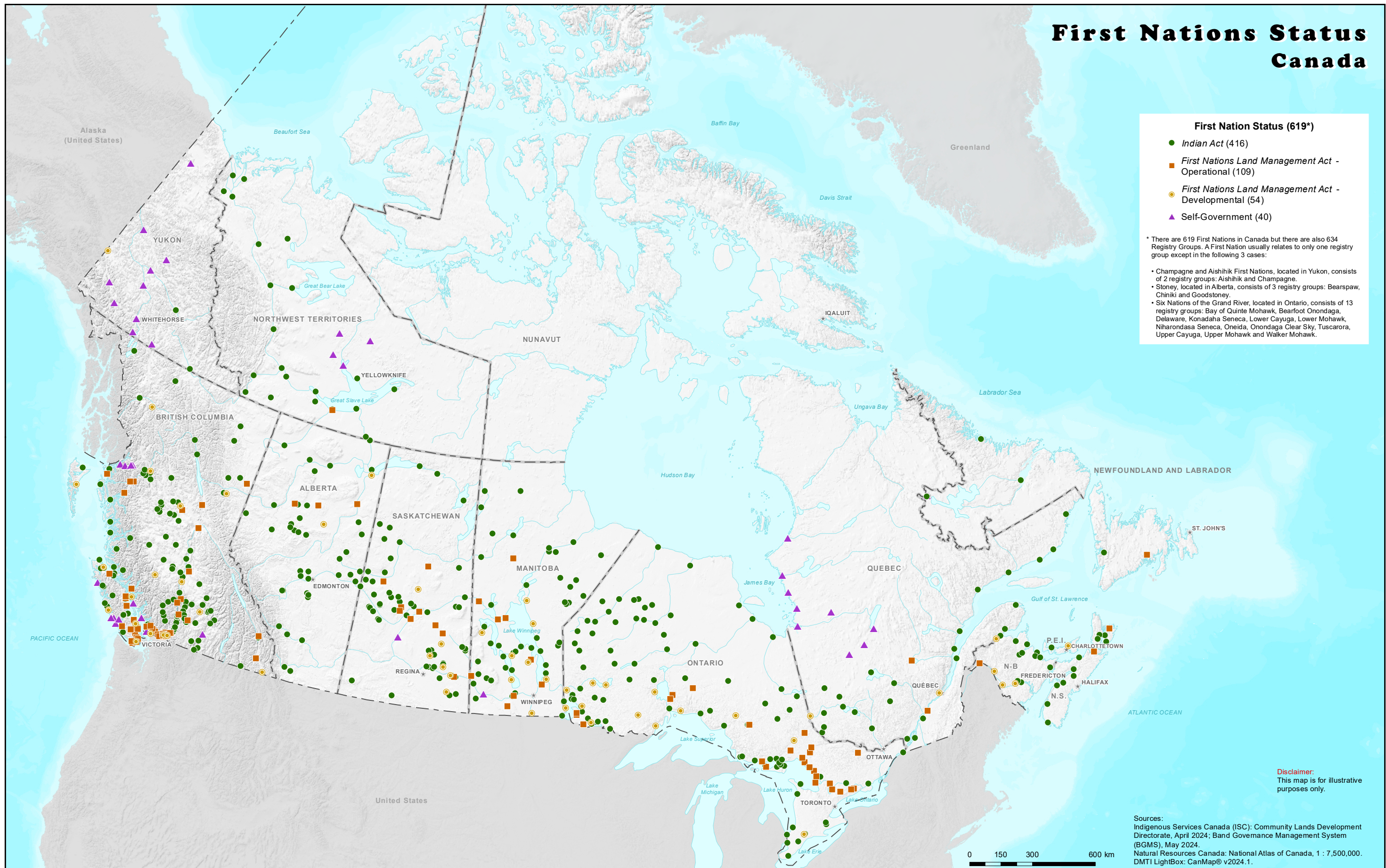

First Nation Status (619*)

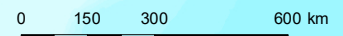
- Indian Act (416)

* There are 619 First Nations in Canada but there are also 634 Registry Groups. A First Nation usually relates to only one registry group except in the following 3 cases:

- Champagne and Aishihik First Nations, located in Yukon, consists of 2 registry groups: Aishihik and Champagne.
- Stoney, located in Alberta, consists of 3 registry groups: Bearspaw, Chiniki and Goodstoney.
- Six Nations of the Grand River, located in Ontario, consists of 13 registry groups: Bay of Quinte Mohawk, Bearfoot Onondaga, Delaware, Konadaha Seneca, Lower Cayuga, Lower Mohawk, Niharonadasa Seneca, Oneida, Onondaga Clear Sky, Tuscarora, Upper Cayuga, Upper Mohawk and Walker Mohawk.
